Chapter 1-Introduction

1-1. Uniform- N/A

1-2. Purpose- To compete and achieve, worldwide, in JLAB and any other Academic and Leadership competitions.

Chapter 2- Command Structure

2-1. Academic Team Commander-The Academic Team Commander conducts the practices, forms the teams, and leads them in competitions. The current Academic Team Commander is C/CSM Anderson

2-2. Academic Team Deputy-The Academic Team Deputy helps the Academic Team Commander conduct the practices, form the teams, and leads them in competitions.

Chapter 3- Practice

3-1. Scheduling-A normal practice should consist of a practice test and any in-depth subjects that need to be covered. (**I.e. Geometry, English, Vocab, etc.**)

3-2. Academic Practice-

3-2-1. Location- All Academic Team practices will be held in Room 813 (The SAI's Classroom)

3-2-2. Leader- The Overall Academic Team Commander will lead the Academic practices.

3-3. Leadership Practice-

3-3-1. Location- All Leadership Team practices will be held in Room 815 (The AI's Classroom).

3-3-2. Leader- The Academic Team Deputy will lead the Leadership Team practices.

Chapter 4- Academic Team Curriculum

4-1. Vocabulary – Refer to SHHS JROTC website

4-2. Geometry – Geometry consists of math questions involving shapes.

4-3. Algebra – Algebra consists of math questions involving numbers and variables, as well as other mathematical materials.

4-4. English – English consists of questions involving reading comprehension and grammar.

4-5. Science – Science consists of questions involving reading charts and graphs as well as questions based on lesson learned in 9th to 10th grade science classes.

4-6. Current Media Events- Current Media consists of questions involving events that have occurred recently in world history.

Chapter 5- Leadership Team Curriculum

5-1. LET I & II- L.E.T. I and L.E.T. II consists of questions involving information learned in JROTC class lessons.

5-2. Map Reading- Map Reading consists of questions involving Orienteering.

5-3. Current Media Events- See **Chapter 4 Section 6**.

Chapter 6- Competition

6-1. Location – The Academic competition occurs in Room 813 (The SAI's classroom). The Leadership competition occurs in Room 815 (The AI's classroom).

6-2. Proctor- Both competitions need to be overseen by a Science Hill school teacher. This is done so that it is confirmed that the teams are not cheating. It is preferred that a science teacher be the proctor. **(Mr. Dosser if available)**
