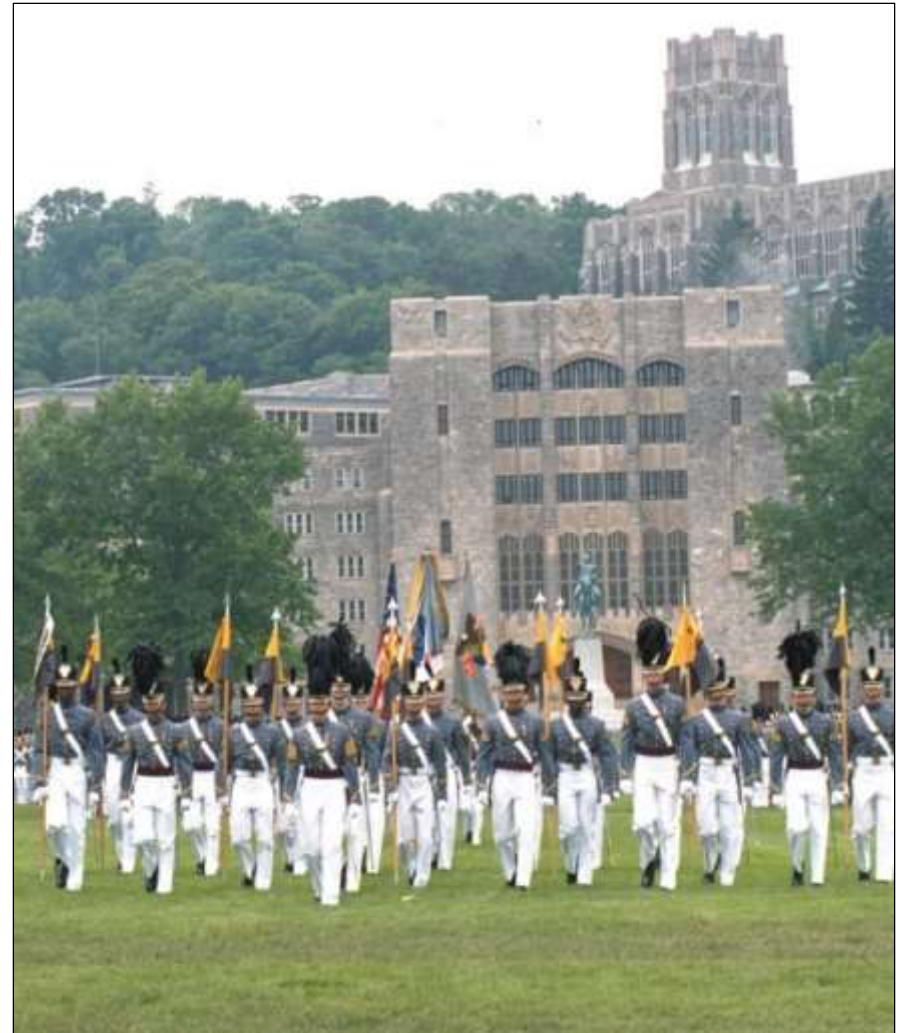


Vision
